
# The Mysteries of the Rosary

# *How to Pray the Rosary*

- 1. Make the *Sign of the Cross* and say the *Apostles Creed* as you hold the cross.
- 2. Say the *Our Father* on the first large bead.
- 3. Say 3 *Hail Mary's* on the three smaller beads.
- 4. Say the *Glory Be* on the next bead.
- 5. Announce the 1st Mystery; then say the *Our Father*.
- 6. Say 10 *Hail Mary's*, while meditating on the Mystery. Count along on the beads as you go.
- 7. Say the *Glory Be* on the next bead.
- 8. Announce the 2nd Mystery; then say the *Our Father*. Repeat 6 & 7 and continue with the 3rd, 4th, & 5th Mysteries in the same manner moving along on the Rosary.
- 9. Say the *Hail Holy Queen;* and any other prayers that might apply.
- 10. Make the Sign of the Cross.
